

DUTCH ELM GOLF COURSE



2 BALL Details

<i>Tee Options (Can change per match/tournament round)</i>		
<i>Men</i>	<i>Women</i>	<i>Senior Men (70+)</i>
<i>Blue or White</i>	<i>White or Red</i>	<i>Blue White or Green</i>
<i>Players must declare the tee prior to the start of the round. To determine who declares their tee first flip a coin or tee.</i>		

You and your partner are responsible for scheduling matches with your opponents. Please contact the Pro Shop if you need contact info. Matches are 18 holes of best ball net match play. For example, lets say Player 1 and 2 are partners, and are playing against Player 3 and 4. Here are the scores for the first hole:

- Player 1 - 6
- Player 2 - 5
- Player 3 - 4
- Player 4 - 7

Without taking into account any strokes, the team of Player 3 and 4 would win this hole with the best score of 4. Therefore, Player 3 and 4 are 1up.

Because all matches are NET match play, let's look at an example with strokes (this is how it will be when you play a match). Using the same scores as the example above, lets say that Player 2 and Player 4 both receive two strokes on the first hole. Your calculation would then look like this:

- Player 1: 6 - 0 strokes = Net 6
- Player 2: 5 - 2 strokes = Net 3
- Player 3: 4 - 0 strokes = Net 4
- Player 4: 7 - 2 strokes = Net 5

We can now see that Player 1 and 2 would win this hole with the best NET score of a 3. Therefore, they would be 1up.

Handicap Comments and Calculations

Before any match begins, please be sure that all players in the match agree on the stroke allocation BEFORE YOUR ROUND BEGINS! Please follow the steps below to calculate the correct number of strokes:

Step 1.) Open/Download USGA GHIN App (link:

Step 2.) Click on "Handicap Calculator"

Step 3.) Search for Dutch Elm Golf Club and select it

Step 4.) Ensure that 18 Holes is selected at the top of your screen, and clear all other golfers that are listed (other than yourself)

Step 5.) Under "Handicap Allowance" select 90%

Step 6.) At the bottom of your screen, select "Add Golfers" and add the 3 other players in your group

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Step 7.) After all players have been added, ensure that the correct tee is selected (tee information can be found at the top of this document.

Step 8.) Each player's allotment of strokes is now displayed under the "S.O." column on the right of your screen

IMPORTANT: You will notice one player will receive 0 strokes. This is because the stroke allocation is based on the lowest handicap.

To allocate the strokes for each player, refer to the Handicap Rating on each hole. In other words, if someone is getting 10 strokes, this mean that they will receive 1 strokes on the 1 through 10 handicap holes

IMPORTANT: Be sure to refer to the handicap rating on the tee that you are playing
